<sup>1</sup>Then the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the Lord. So the Lord delivered them into the hands of Midian for seven years, <sup>2</sup>and the hand of Midian prevailed against Israel. Because of the Midianites, the children of Israel made for themselves the dens, the caves, and the strongholds which are in the mountains...<sup>11</sup>Now the angel of the Lord came and sat under the terebinth at Ophrah, which belonged to Joash the Abierrite, while his son Gideon was beating out wheat in the winepress to hide it from the Midianites. <sup>12</sup>And the angel of the Lord appeared to him and said to him, "The Lord is with you, O mighty man of valour." <sup>13</sup>And Gideon said to him, "Please, my lord, if the Lord is with us, why then has all this happened to us? And where are all His wonderful deeds that our fathers recounted to us, saying, 'Did not the Lord bring us up from Egypt?' But now the Lord has forsaken us and given us into the hands of Midian." <sup>14</sup>And the Lord turned to him and said, "Go in this might of yours and save Israel from the hand of Midian; do not I send you?"<sup>15</sup>And he said to Him, "Please, Lord, how can I save Israel? Behold, my clan is the weakest in Manasseh, and I am the least in my father's house." <sup>16</sup>And the Lord said to him, "But I will be with you, and you shall strike the Medianites as a one man." <sup>17</sup>And he said to Him, "If now I have found favour in your eyes, then show me a sign that it is you who speak with me. <sup>18</sup>Please do not depart from me here until I come to you and bring out my present and

set it before you." And He said, I will stay till you return." <sup>19</sup>So Gideon went into his house and prepared a young goat and unleavened cakes from an ephah of flour. The meat he put in a basket and the broth he put in a pot, and brought them to him under the terebinth and presented them." And the angel of God said, "Take the meat and the unleavened cakes, and out them on this rock, and pour the broth over them..." <sup>22</sup> Then Gideon perceived that he was with the angel of the Lord. And Gideon said, "Alas, O Lord God! For now I have seen the angel of the Lord face to face..." <sup>34</sup> But the Spirit of the Lord came upon Gideon, then blew the trumpet, and the Abiezrites gathered behind him.
