## Writing and Presenting

### Section A: Creative Writing

#### Instructions:

- There are three topics: you may only use one in your creative writing
- State the topic you have chosen before writing your story.
- The title of your essay should be: **Never take your body for granted**
- Draw up a mind map
- Write the first draft of your story and edit your work: correct any spelling, language and punctuation errors.
- Write neatly the final draft. Pay attention to your handwriting and spacing.

#### Topics

1. Write an essay about a time you were ill in bed. In your essay say:
  - What was wrong with you, e.g. measles, flu, a cold
  - Who came to visit you
  - How long you stayed in bed
  - What you did while you were ill
  - What the first thing was that you did when you felt better

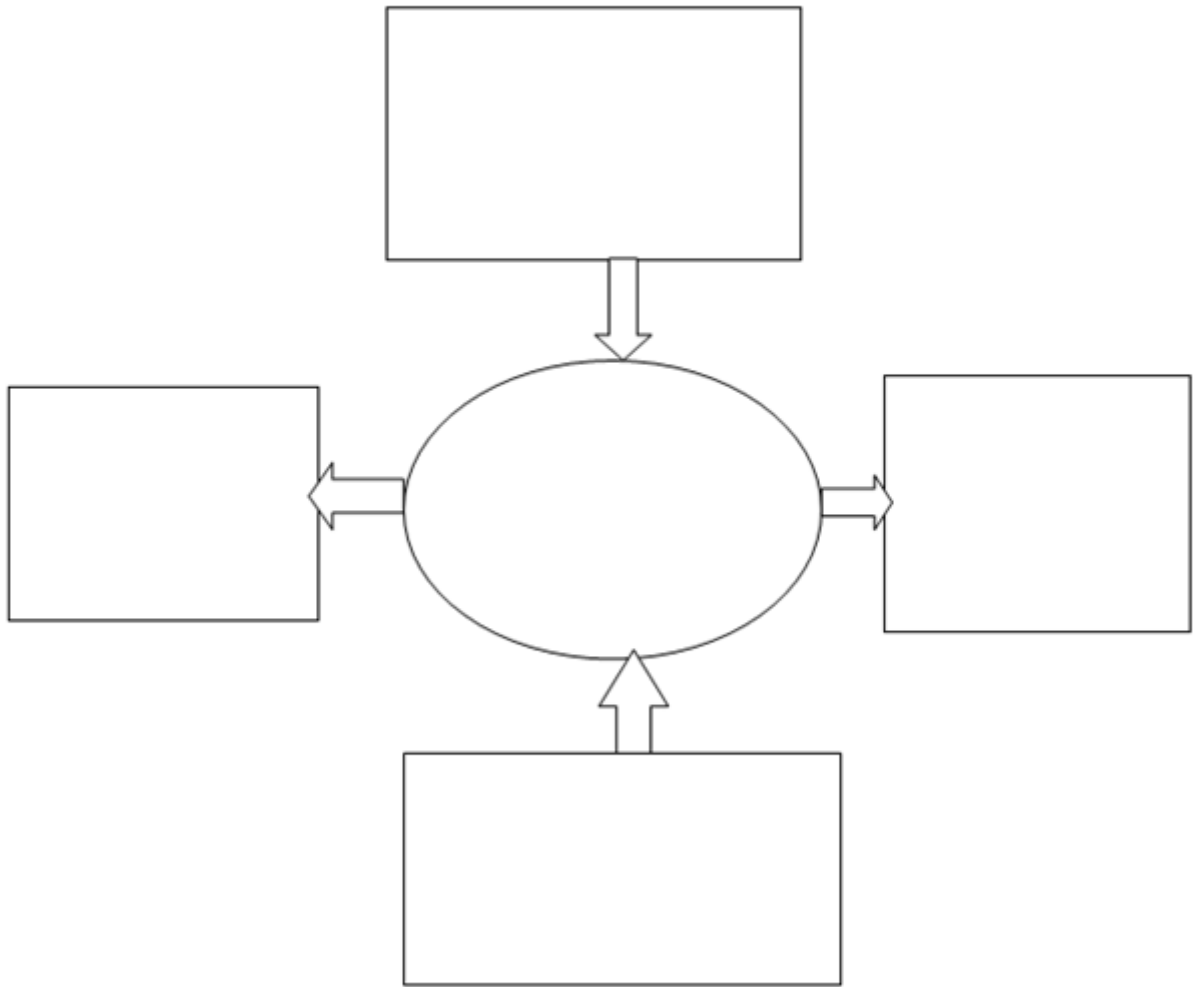
2. Write an essay about an operation you had. Remember to write about.

- How you felt before the operation you had e.g. were you very ill?
- How you felt about the operation, e.g. scared, worried, confused
- Who came to visit you in hospital
- How long you stayed in hospital
- How good it felt when you were well again

3. A family member or friend might have been in hospital. Write an essay in which you tell.

- Who it was that was in hospital
- Why he/she was in hospital
- How you felt when you went to visit the person
- What your observations were of the hospital, e.g. the noise, smells, staff, other patients
- How the person has recovered.
