The development of the Afrikaans language

The slaves came from many different places and did not have one common language. They all learnt Dutch to communicate with each other and with the slave owners. The slaves added words from their own languages. In time, this language became Afrikaans.



In this picture, Muslim students are learning to read and write. They were taught in Afrikaans.

We can see the slave influence in many words in Afrikaans. These words originally came from languages that the slaves spoke. For example, *baie* (a lot), *piesang* (banana), *blatjang* (chutney) and *sjambok* (whip) all came from languages the slaves spoke.
